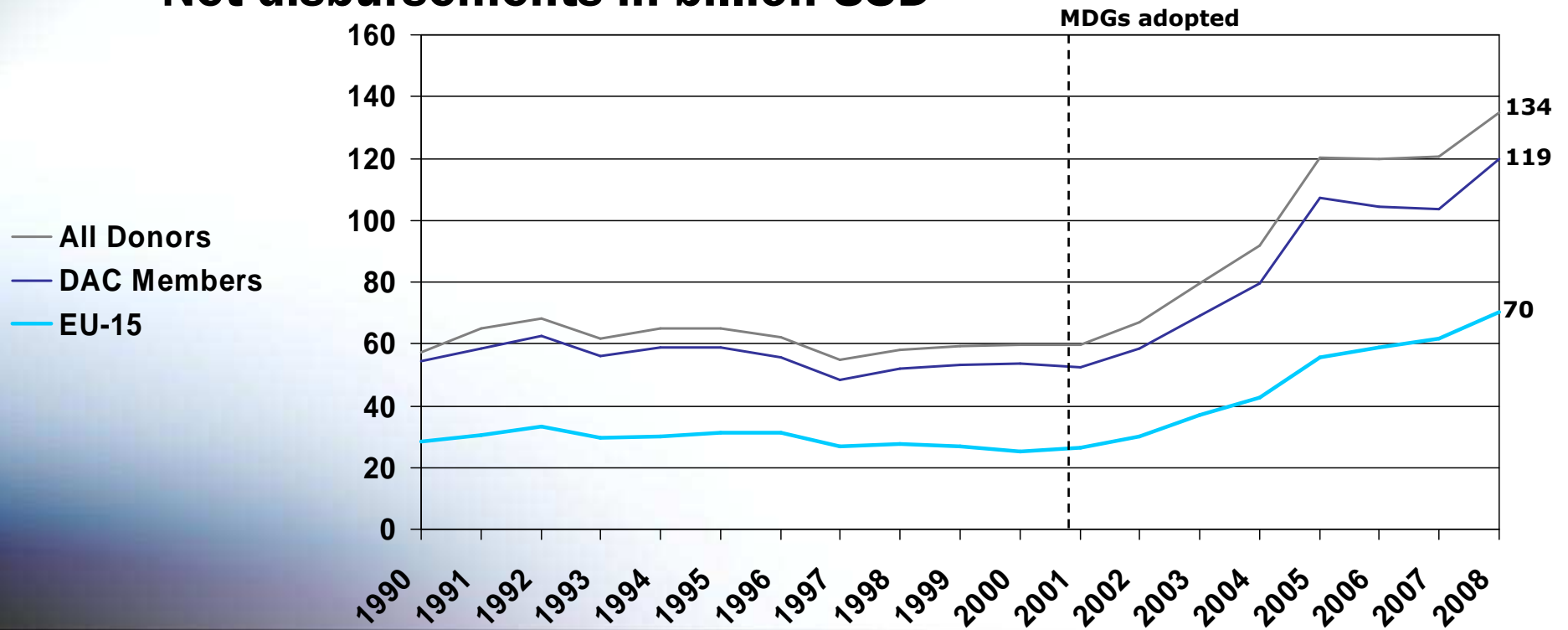

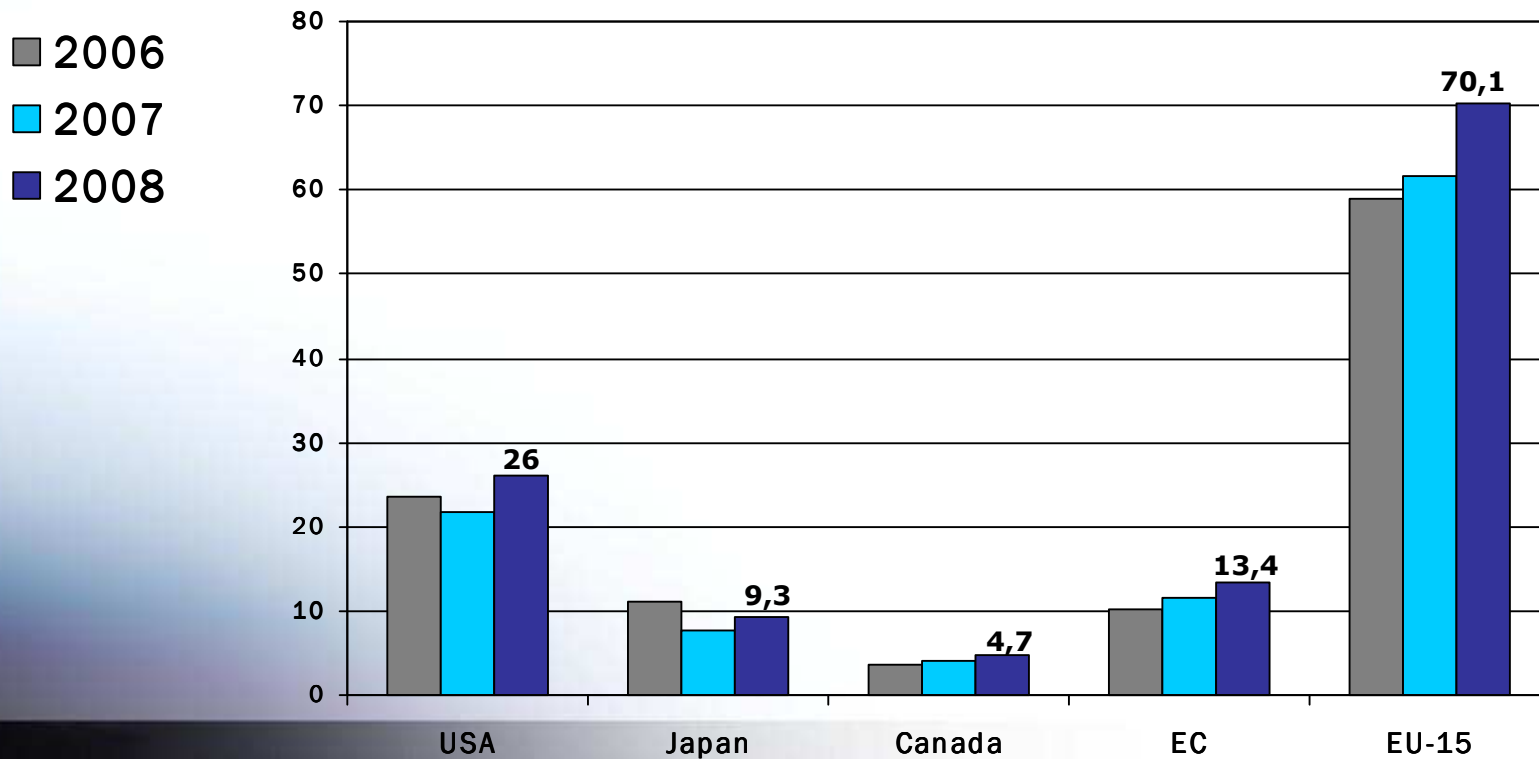

## Net disbursements in billion USD

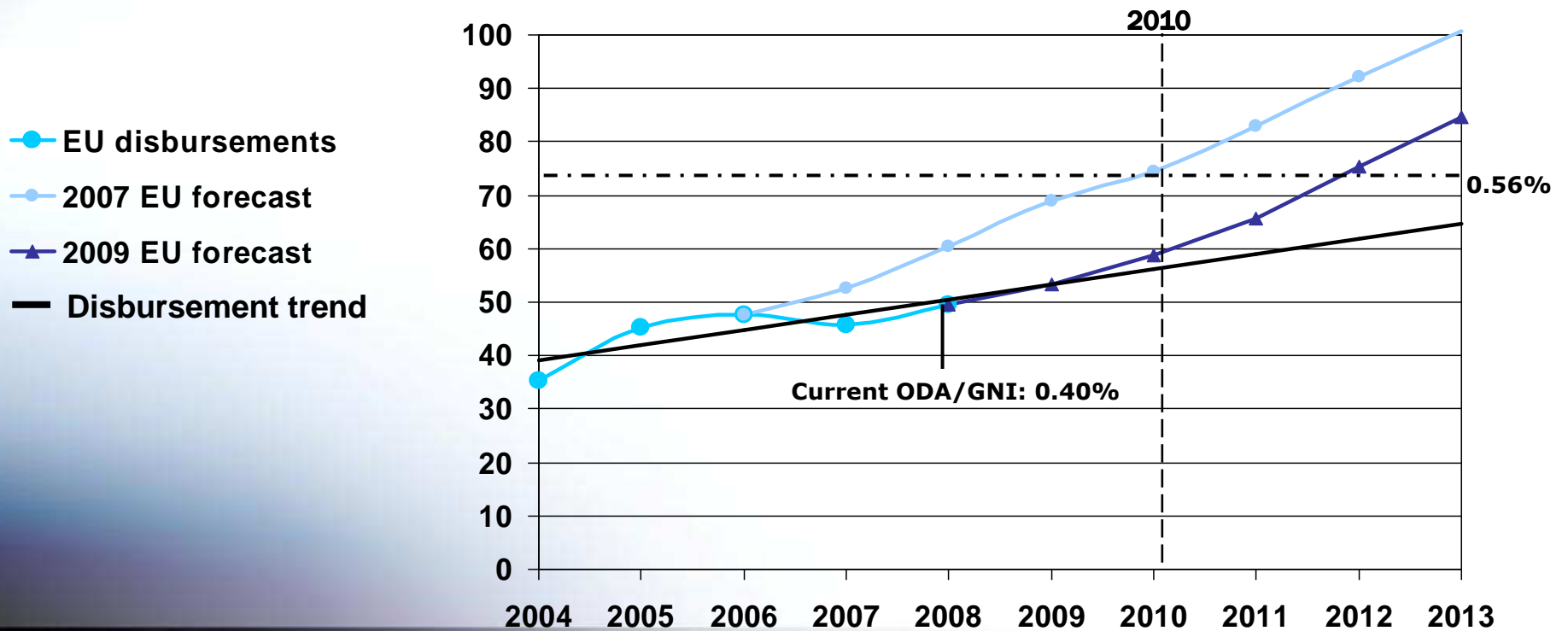

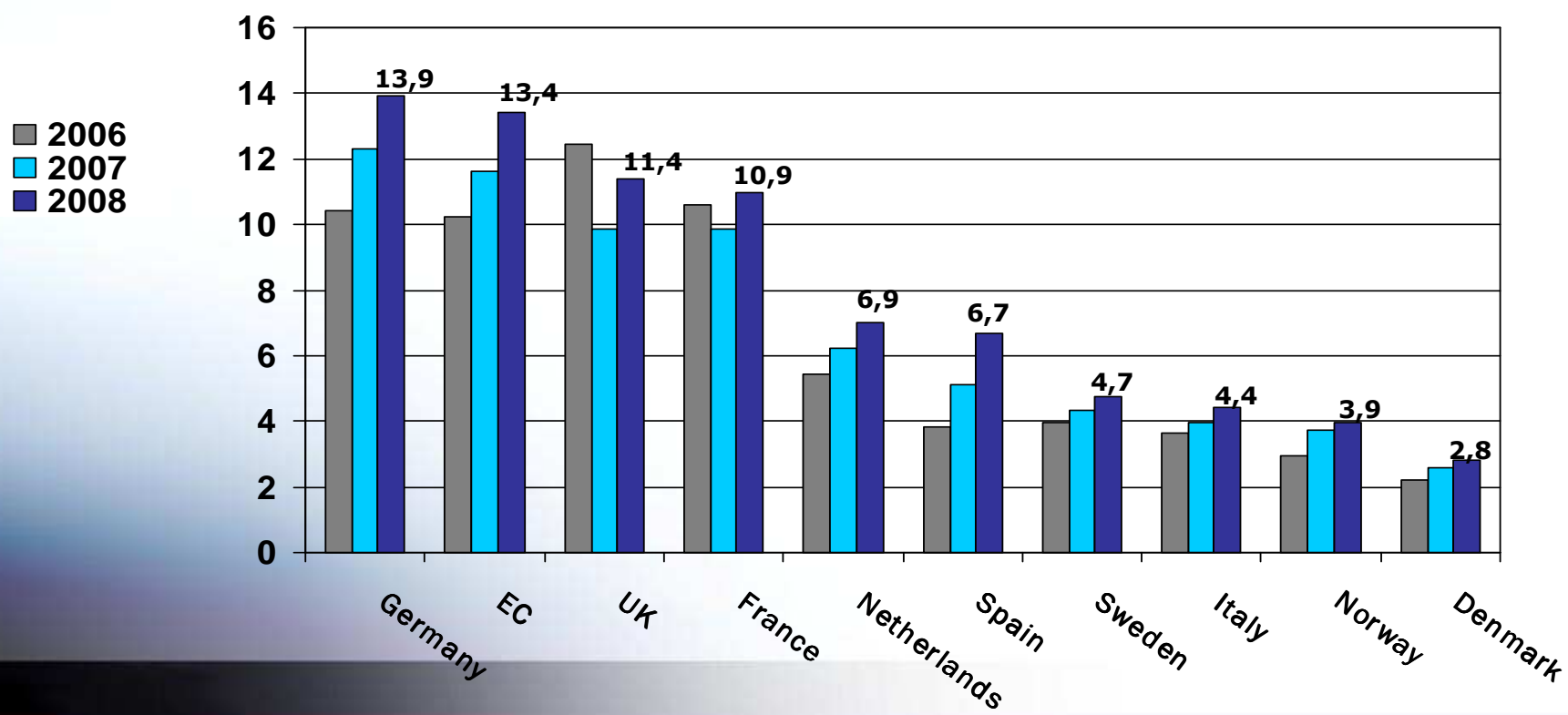
### Global ODA net disbursements in billion USD

## Top 10 European donors in 2008 ODA net disbursements in billion USD



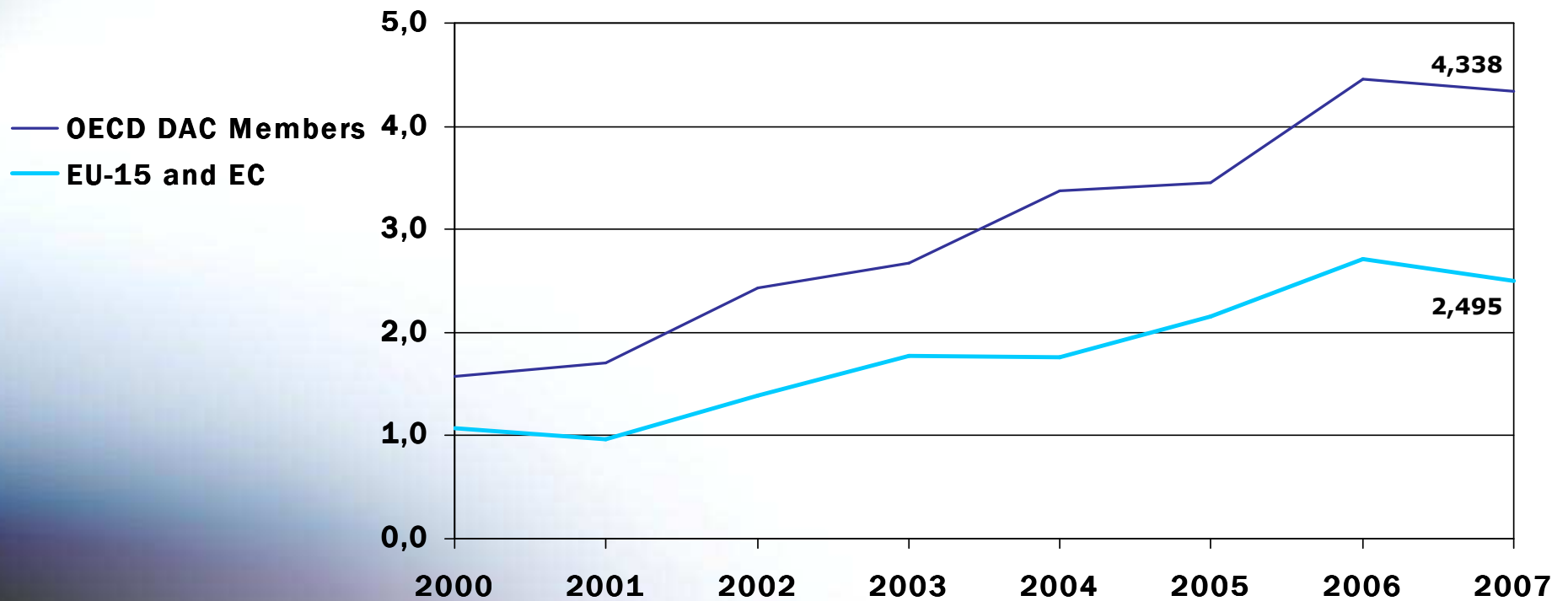

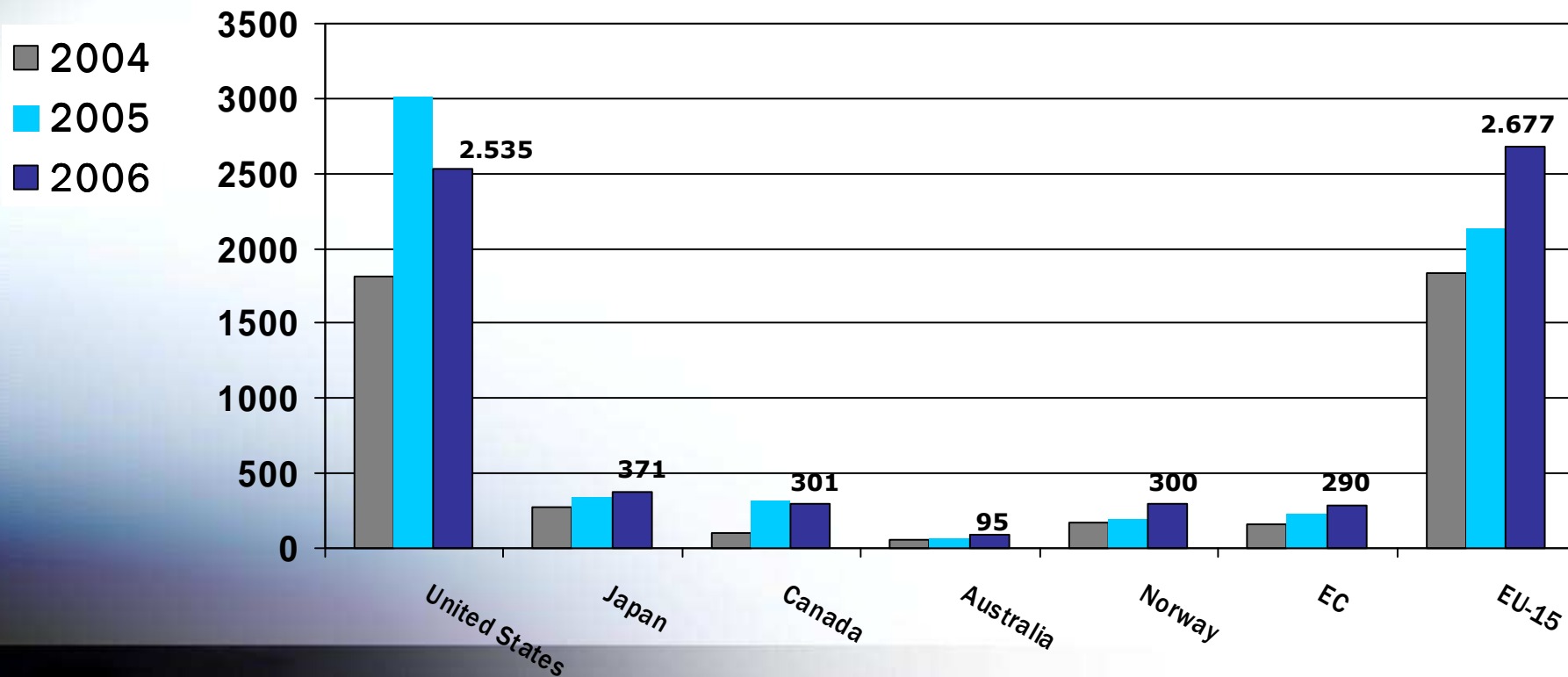

## Health ODA efforts from 2000 to 2007

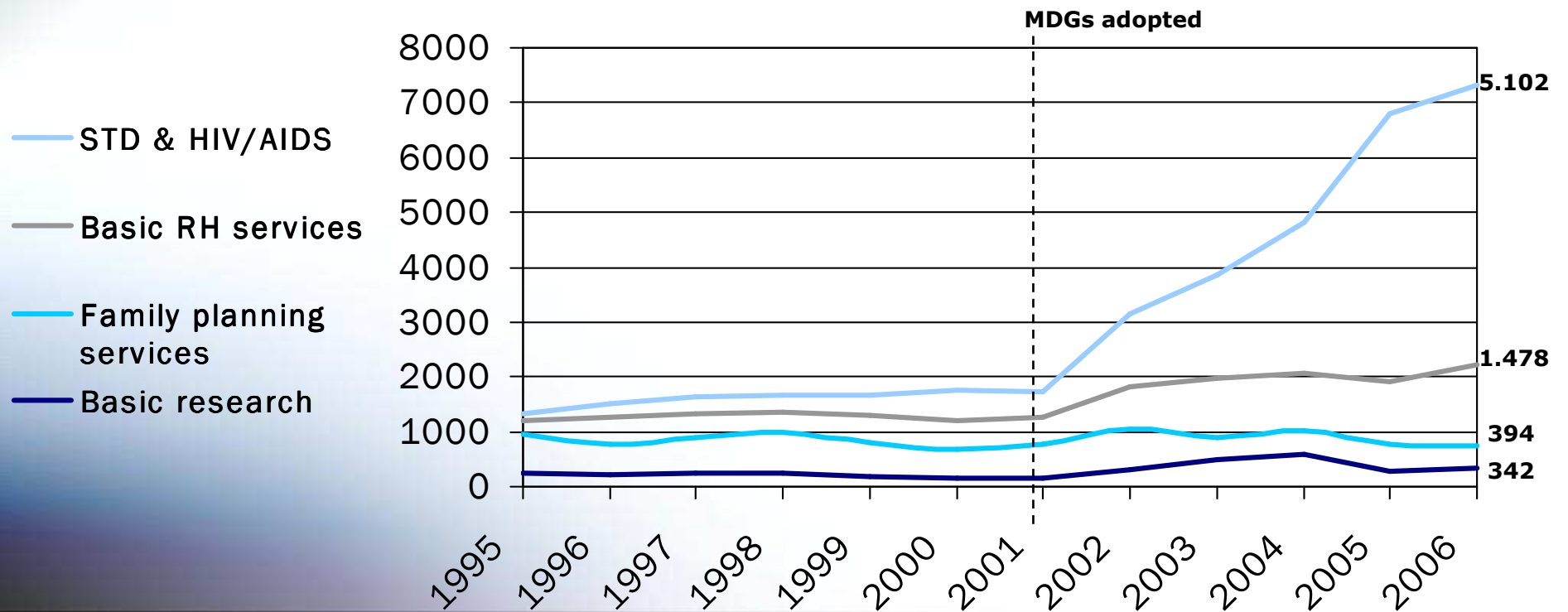
### ODA net disbursements in billion USD

## Breakdown of Population Assistance 1999-2006 in million USD



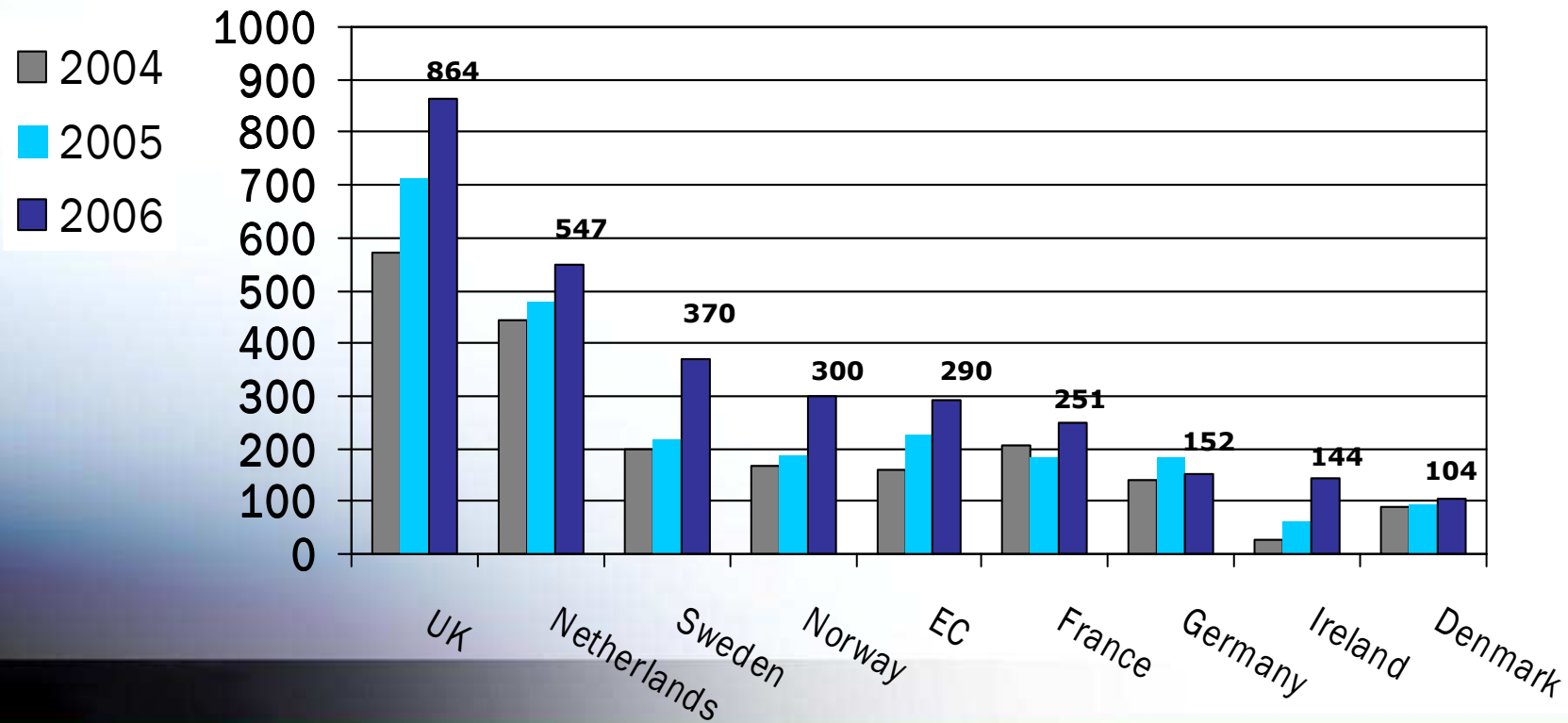

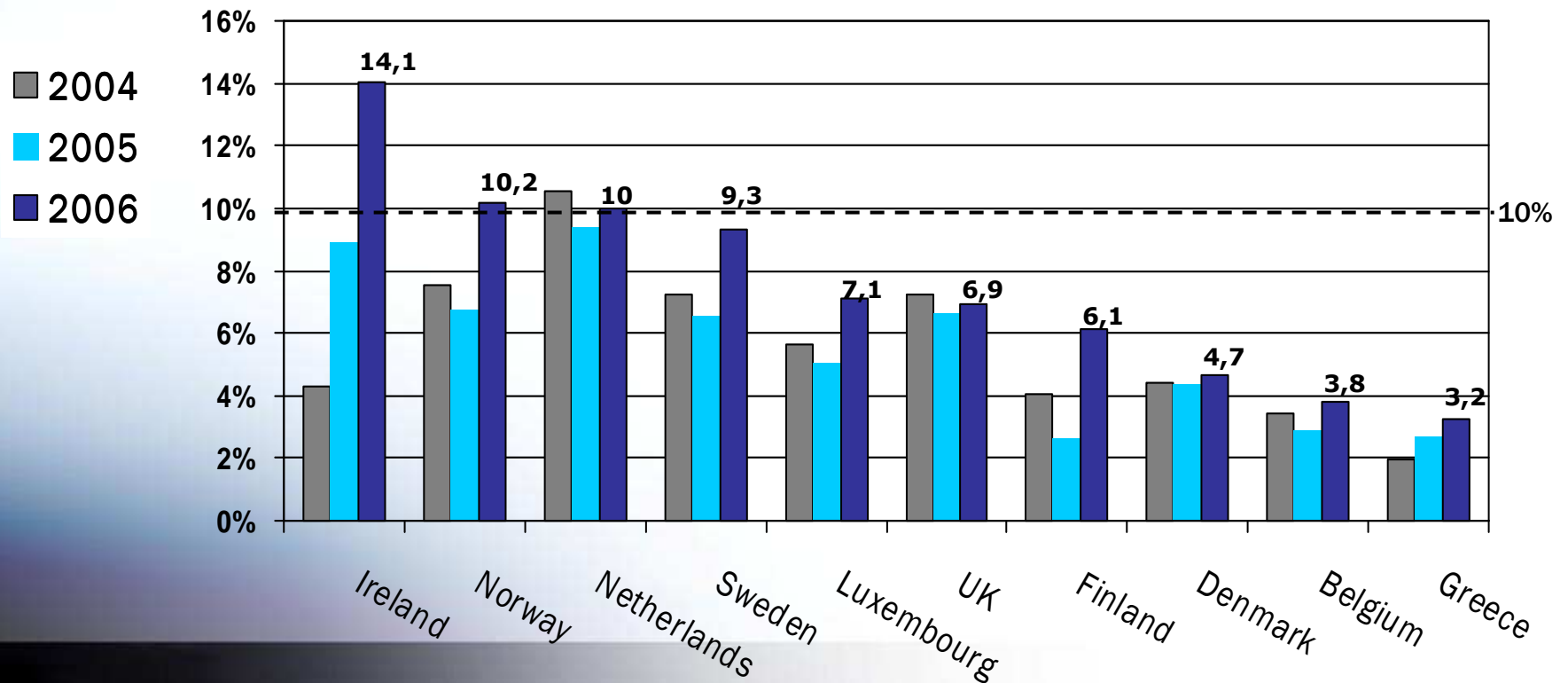

## Spending on population assistance 2004-2006, in million USD

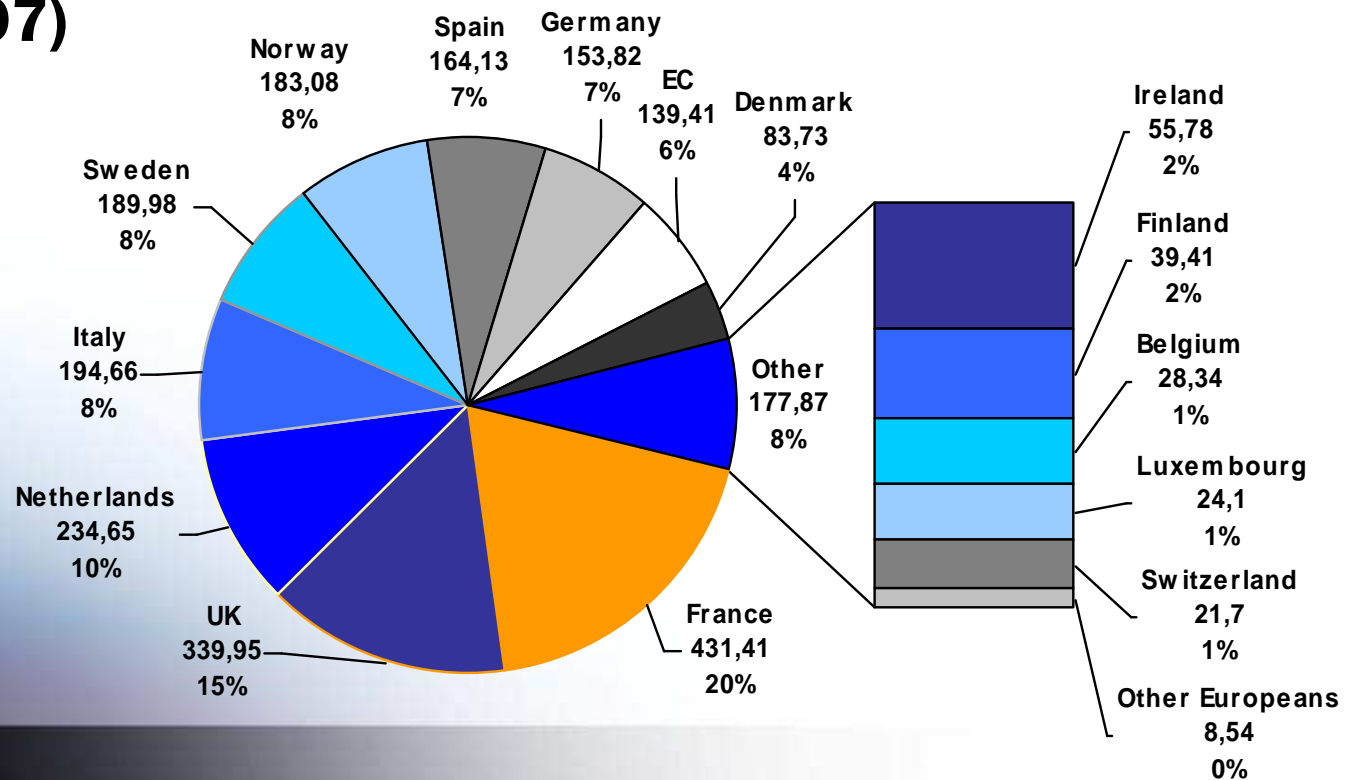


## Spending on population assistance 2004-2006, as % of ODA



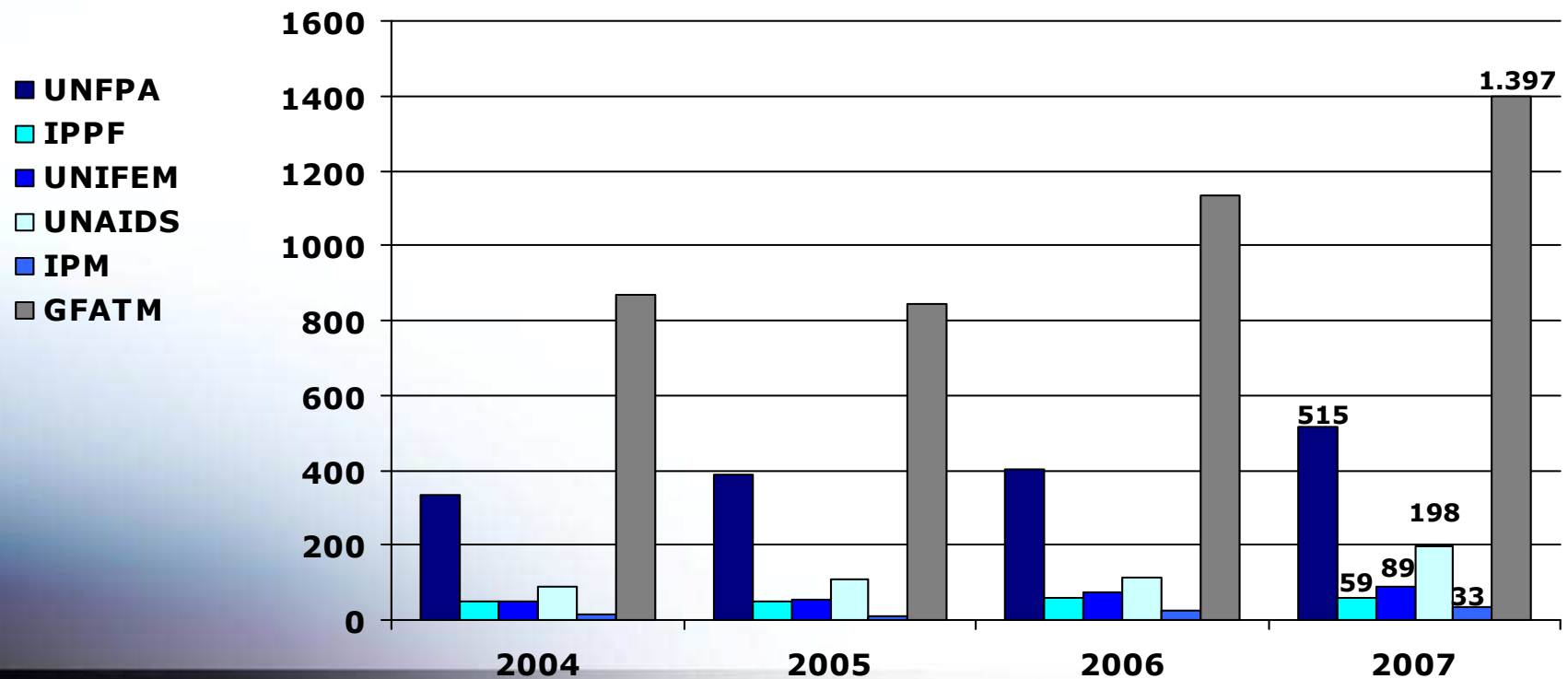

# Contributions to SRHR-related Organisations

## European contributions (2004-2007) by organisation in million USD



- **Civil society and parliaments need to be more involved in budget-setting and watchdog monitoring in developing countries**
- **Increased transparency and accountability needed to assure ICPD gets sufficient funding – funds flows increasingly obscured by general budget support**
- **The EU “division of labour” is increasing aid coordination at both the EU and developing country levels, with EU MS actually delegating their authority by sector to manage aid in developing countries**
