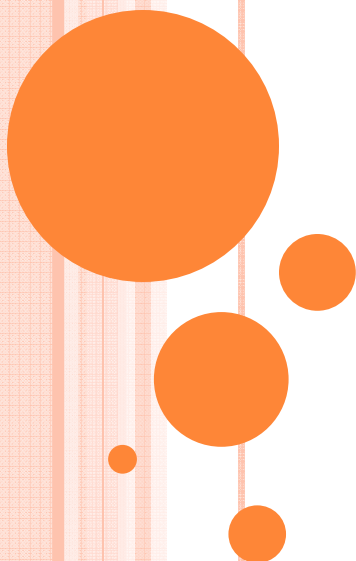

# THE NORTH SOUTH PARTNERSHIP: ACCOUNTABILITY

- A Global standard for transparency and accountability for donors and governments
- North and south collaboration focusing on accountability which includes organizations in the north focusing on donor accountability and collaborating with those in the south focusing on government accountability
- Create a working group (N&S) bringing together organizations working on budgets with organizations doing public policy accountability on SRHR issues
- Generate an implementation process for the previous recommendations including specific mechanisms for convening agenda setting and reporting



# STRENGTHEN THE NORTH SOUTH PARTNERSHIP: INFLUENCING POLICY OUTCOMES

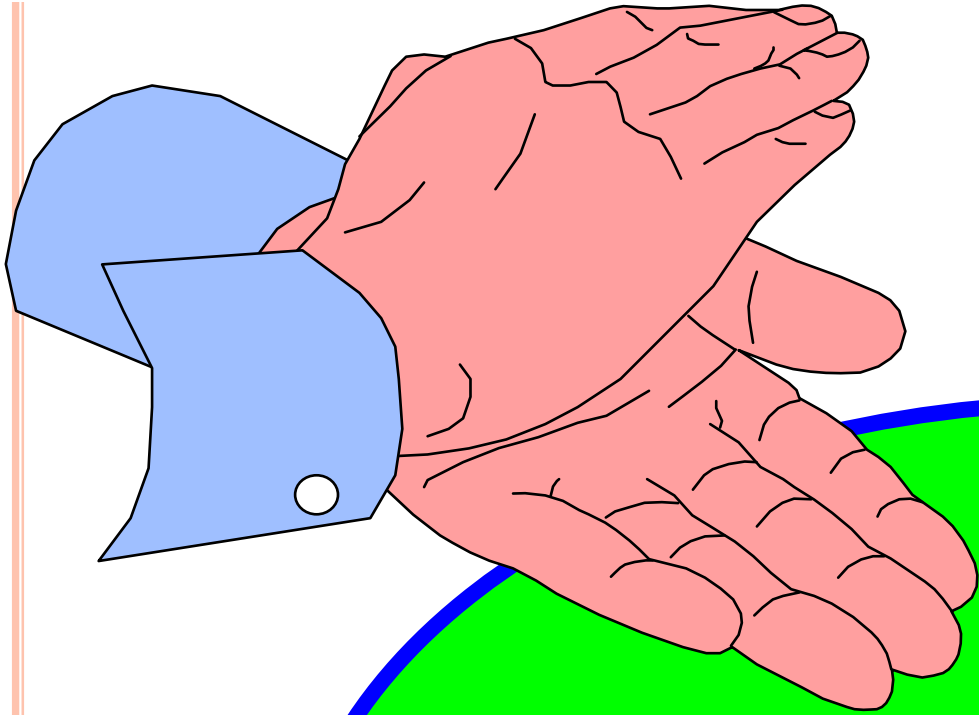
- Educate and train key policy makers and influential civil servants so SRHR becomes a policy issue
- Need a tool kit that serves both the NGOs in the north and the south in order to be able to do the training
- Build and strengthen a vibrant southern NGO led movement
- Huge information by NGOs and networks in the N&S; this information should be harnessed
- More N&S engagement through meetings
- An inter-governmental meeting in 2014/15 to get heads of state together to make a new plan looking beyond 2015.
- Next EURONGOS meeting to be held in the south



# RECOMMENDATIONS TO STRENGTHEN THE NORTH SOUTH PARTNERSHIP: COMMUNICATION

- Documentation, sharing of experiences in the field of RH, P and D
- Establish/strengthen communication networks/channels for information sharing
- Devise channels of reaching out to the parliamentarians and other policy makers
- Link the education and communication strategies especially the informal education. Make creative campaigns
- Target the media through capacity building trainings
- Develop clear concise messages for different target audiences
- Campaign “holding hands across the world”
- Learning from other movements like the HIV/AIDS campaign
- Mobilize donor support for this N and S advocacy
- Synthesize the call to action into one paragraph
