

# TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR PARTNERSHIP ADVISORY GROUP

## **FUNCTION:**

The Advisory Group is a group of experts that provide advice to the Steering Committee, especially with regards to the development of the proposed joint agenda for the SRHR Partnership. The Advisory Group can also be called upon to contribute to workshops, working groups and other activities, when appropriate.

## **MEMBERS:**

The Steering Committee will invite and select representatives from entities working on the domestic and/or international SRHR agenda in Europe that are experts in certain SRHR topics to serve on the Advisory Group. The Advisory Group can consist of members, friends or allies of the SRHR Partnership.

## **MEETINGS:**

The Advisory Group meets regularly with the Steering Committee to provide advice and guidance. Meetings will take place at least quarterly but may be as frequent as monthly in the lead up to the annual conference during which the joint agenda for the SRHR Partnership will be evaluated. In addition, the Advisory Group may be consulted on an ad hoc basis by the Steering Committee or Secretariat when their expert-advice is required.
